**1996-1997 ADDENDUM:
BUTTERFLY NOTATION**

NORTHERN METALMARK (CALEPHELIS BOREALIS)

On July 6, 1996, Jerome Lippert and Wayne Wauligman found and photographed a Northern Metalmark in the power line path. This occurred about 5 pm on a sunny, warm day. The photo, sent to Bob Nuhn, was verified as such.

On July 5, 1997, Jerome Lippert, Wayne Wauligman and Don Johnson again found two Northern Metalmark butterflies at the same location. This happened shortly before 4 pm during the annual butterfly count.

Because the power line right of way had been cleared of small trees, shrubs and weeds after July 1996, we thought the Metalmark might not be found here again. Since it is still present, we suspect its food plant, roundleaf ragwort, may be in the adjacent woods and not in the power path.

This location is marked on the enclosed topo map of the Lake Tract.
